Use Facebook to support Project Koru: *We are an official nonprofit of Facebook!*

In a new post, under “What’s on your mind?”, go down to “Support a Nonprofit” - it will find Project Koru if you start typing it in and boom! You fundraise through facebook and all funds get sent directly to Project Koru.


Thank your supporters.
