We will be keeping to commission rate at 20% to ensure artists can benefit well from the exhibition. All artworks are insured by Wildflower Sculpture Exhibition from installation weekend until the week following the exhibition.

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Background

The inaugural Wildflower Sculpture Exhibition was held in 2008. Over the five previous exhibitions (in 2008, 2010, 2012, 2014 and 2016), over 22,000 visitors have been welcomed to Round Pond Garden to view and purchase works from Hawke's Bay and New Zealand artists.

Our event is held in association with two other fundraisers for Cranford Hospice, The Hawke's Bay Wine Auction and the Hospice Holly Trail.

Since 2008 the Wildflower Sculpture Exhibition has raised and donated \$221,000 to Cranford Hospice.
