In February 2018, **Adalah Justice Project** invited 30 individuals to gather together as part of a collective visioning experience designed to strengthen relationships, identify best practices and take the most effective and beautiful next steps towards victory. Participants shared a connection to and commitment to justice, freedom and equality for Palestine, and are actively working towards Native liberation, the decolonization of Puerto Rico, immigrant justice, Black liberation, economic and environmental justice, gender and trans justice.

The People’s Library, a compilation of the books, articles and films that informed the participants’ worldview and work is shared as a collective resource and inspiration.
