

Contraindications for Colon Hydrotherapy

Contraindication is a condition where it is unsafe to receive a session unless approved by a doctor.

- Severe Cardiac disease
- Severe Anemia
- Abdominal Surgery within 12 weeks
- Aneurysm
- Anticoagulation or prescription blood thinners
- Abdominal Hernia
- Cirrhosis of the Liver
- Congestive Heart Failure
- Colorectal Cancer
- Colon or Rectal surgery (1 year or less)
- Carcinoma of the colon or rectum
- Crohn's Disease active or severe
- Severe Colitis
- Diverticulitis
- Epilepsy and Seizures- when uncontrolled
- Fissures and Fistulas- if painful and bleeding
- GI Hemorrhage/perforation
- Dialysis-Kidney weakness makes it challenging to manage water absorption in colon
- Pregnancy
- Prostatitis: when acute or inflamed
- Psychosis
- Renal Insufficiency or Tumor on the Kidney
- Ulcerative Colitis when severe or active

If you have any of the above listed conditions, colon hydrotherapy CANNOT be done.
