

# Sapphire Point- Silverthorne, CO

Sapphire Point Overlook sits between Keystone and Breckenridge at an elevation of 9,500 feet. The overlook offers a stunning view of Dillon Reservoir and the rocky mountains.

## VRBO on Copper Mountain- Copper, CO

This location is perfect for a ski in and ski out adventure elopement, located right on Copper Mountain. This luxurious home can sleep up to 28 people!

## VRBO in Keystone, CO

This is a perfect location to have a wedding or elopement, right on the property! This 9 bedroom luxurious home has everything for a comfortable stay, and gorgeous wedding all in one.

# The Maroon Bells- Apen, CO

The Maroon Bells is one of the most iconic views in Colorado.
Reservations can be made from Memorial Day- October, and on weekdays. Planning ahead is best to get a specific date you want.

# Windy Point- Silverthorne, CO

This location is great because on top of a beautiful ceremony location on the lake, you also get a private pavillion for your outdoor reception with amazing views.



#### Lake Isabelle in Indian Peaks Wilderness

Full Day adventure couples can also hike the 4.2 mile round trip to Lake Isabelle with plenty of stops along the trail including tree groves, grass fields, and the mountain views too!

### Chautauqua Park- Boulder, CO

This location has a great view of the Flatirons, and you have many options to choose from if you decide to get married with this mountain view. Plus you are so close to Boulder, if you choose to have a celebration afterwards.

### Halfway House on Flagstaff Mountain- Boulder, CO

This enclosed stone facility can host up to 49 people (covid depending), with magnificent views of Boulder Valley.

## VRBO in Lyons, CO

This location allows for up to 20 guests, and can sleep all 20! You can do a ceremony and reception on the property, or adventure out to RMNP. There is a venue fee in addition to the fee to stay.

# Sunrise Ampitheatre- Boulder, CO

This location has some of the best views that overlook the town of Boulder. You can choose to elope at sunrise, or later in the day. After the ceremony, you can head to Lost Gulch for some really epic mountain views.



## Lory State Park- Bellvue, CO

Experience the beauty of Colorado and plan a one-of-a-kind outdoor wedding at Lory State Park. With easy and convenient access from Fort Collins, Lory makes an ideal wedding location!

## Eagle Eye Shelter at Mt. Falcon- Morrison, CO

Close to Denver but away from the city is Mount Falcon State Park. With a short hike in, the Eagle Eye Shelter offers some great views of the park, and nearby you can head to Red Rocks Ampitheatre after.

## Horsetooth Reservoir- Fort Collins, CO

One of the best views on the Front Range is the iconic Horsetooth Reservoir. If you are looking for a great spot to say your I Do's, this perfect spot has great views of Fort Collins, the foothills, and the reservoir.

## The Elizabeth Hotel- Fort Collins, CO

If you are looking for an urban venue this boutique hotel in the heart of Old Town Fort Collins is a great space for an elopement or micro wedding.

## Garden of The Gods- Colorado Springs, CO

If you are looking for a ceremony location, the red rock features at Garden of The Gods creates an incredible backdrop for your elopement. There are a number of locations to choose from that allow for up to 50 people.



#### Panorama Point in Golden Gate State Park

This state park has great panoramic views, especially in the fall when the leaves change colors. Consider a camp spot for two or group picnic area for a small reception afterwards.

## St. Mary's Glacier- Idaho Springs, CO

For the adventurous couples that are looking for a full day elopement experience, St. Mary's Glacier is a great spot for a little adventure. The short 1.5 mile round trip hike offers some stellar views with the snow.

#### Lookout Mountain- Golden, CO

Lookout Mountain offers a stunning mountain backdrop for your elopement, without having to travel too far from Denver. You get the mountain landscaping, forest, and beautiful sunsets at this location.

# <u>Evergreen Lake House- Evergreen, CO</u>

This spot if perfect for a micro wedding or a wedding reception. If you are looking for lakeside views their deck is a great place to have a ceremony, and rent the indoor reception hall if you plan to stay longer.

## Juniper Mountain House- Evergreen, CO

This boutique hotel and event space overlooks the foothills of Evergreen, CO and just 30 minutes from Denver. Pricing includes the entire hotel for the night (sleeps 11), as well as an intimate reception or ceremony only option. (Pricing is in addition to the elopement package)



# Rocky Mountain National Park- Estes Park, CO

RMNP is one of Colorado's gems. There is a very limited number of wedding permits allowed per year so this location is best for those planning a year or more ahead.

## O'Connor Pavillion- Estes Park, CO

This location backs up to Rocky Mountain National Park, and offers some great views of the mountains, meadows, and trees. It is also close enough to go into RMNP before or after for pictures.

## VRBO in Grandby, CO

This location sleeps 20 people and can host events up to 40 people. It has gorgous views that overlook the town of Grandby. There is a venue fee in addition to the nightly fee for events.

## Point Park- Grand Lake, CO

This location is perfect for the intimate lakeside mountain elopement. With the access to the private dock on Grand lake you can exchange vows, then head around the area for some stellar photos.

### Shadow Mountain Lakehouse- Grand Lake, CO

This lakefront lodge is perfect for a mountain, lakeside wedding or elopement. The house sleeps 11 guests, and has a private boat dock, beautiful lawn and patio, and plenty of space to host a ceremony and reception.



## Brainard Lake- Ward, CO

If you envision saying your vows next to a gorgeous mountain lake and landscape, this is a good location. For up to 12 guests you can visit the lake for your elopement at any time of the year. And it is dog friendly too!
