Pinot Noir, Shea Vineyard, Penner-Ash – Yamhill-Carlton, Oregon	95
Savory notes of sweet earth mixed with rich cherry and summer ripened blueberries, layered with hints of dark brown sugar .	
Pinot Noir, Wrath Cellars – Santa Lucia Highlands, California	80
Beautiful aromas of dried cherry and terroir, this is a powerful yet elegant Pinot Noir.	
**Pinot Noir, Gold Ridge Vineyard, Semper – Russian River Valley, California	130
Complex aromas of mountain strawberries and aged cigar & tobacco lead entry to gorgeous layers of kirsch, truffle, and fresh raspberries.	
Corton Grand Cru, Maison Ambroise – Burgundy, France	175
A big wine with excellent muscle, concentration and power to the big-bodied flavors that coat the palate with dry extract, all wrapped in a serious, highly persistent and well-balanced finish.	
Zinfandel, Terraces Vineyards - Napa Valley, California	52
Deep purple in color, this rich and voluptuous wine has pronounced notes of blueberries and spice.	
Syrah, Penner-Ash – Oregon	45
Enticing black fruit and dark rose petals pair with sweet leather and smoky barrel spice.	
Syrah, "Precious" Southern Bell - Jumilla, Spain	65
Aged in 20 yr. old Pappy Van Winkle Bourbon Casks. Dry, full bodied, and rich. Very limited production.	
Red Blend, "Sucker Punch", JCK Wine Co. – Sonoma, California	60
Syrah, Grenache, Viognier. Dense ruby/purple color, gorgeous blackberry and black raspberry.	
Petite Sirah, Mettler Vineyards – Lodi, California	50
This intensely hued, aromatic wine jumps out of the glass with rich blackberry fruit backed up by a beautiful structure and polished tannin. Full bodied and supple.	

Cabernet Franc, "Inkblot" Michael David – Lodi, California	55
Bold flavors with cinnamon spice and toasty oak, dense raspberry and currant.	
Red Blend, "Abstract" Orin Swift Cellars – California	65
Grenache, Syrah, Petite Sirah. Inky in color with fresh fruit and a voluptuous texture.	
Red Blend, "Scout's Honor" Venge Vineyards – Napa Valley, California	65
Zinfandel, Petite Sirah, Charbono, Syrah. Light violets, crushed herbs and licorice abound in this mouthwatering, inky red blend.	
Cabernet Sauvignon, Trainwreck Cellars - Sonoma County, California	45
Deep, dark, and full of ripe black fruit with soft spice.	
Cabernet Sauvignon, "Double Lariat" Jamieson Ranch – Napa Valley, California	60
Cassis and black cherry dance on the palate framed by supple tannins and a lengthy finish.	
Cabernet Sauvignon, Ehlers Estate – St. Helena, California	85
Layered with blackberry, black raspberry, caramel and dark chocolate, sporting a great structure and solid backbone.	
Cabernet Sauvignon, "Love Hammer" SLOdown Wines – Napa Valley, California	115
Dark and inky with intense aromatics of dark chocolate and clove decadently give way to rum raisin, leather and red berries on the palate. 100% Cabernet from Atlas Peak, less than 300 cases produced.	
Cabernet Sauvignon, "Artemis", SLWC – Napa Valley, California (375ml)	60
Blackberries, plums and a hint of vanilla shows in this classic wine; medium bodied with satin-like tannin.	
Cabernet Sauvignon, Duckhorn Vineyards – Napa Valley, California	120
Generous yet graceful, this lovely Cabernet leads with smoky pipe tobacco and plum, layered with an elegant structure and long, expressive finish.	
Red Blend, "Concept – The Benchland" Cain Vineyards – Napa Valley, California	130
Aromas of pound cake, dried cherries and mocha. Fine tannins create a luxurious wine that has a silky body and gentle finish.	
Cabernet Sauvignon, Silver Oak – Alexander Valley, California 2007	180
100% Cabernet, recently released from the "Library Collection". Aromas and flavors of violet, blackberry and dark chocolate.	
Cabernet Sauvignon, "Sympa" St. Helena Winery – Napa Valley, California	2009 180
Famed winemaker Aaron Pott and Elizabeth Tangney join together with the idea of making	2012 225
estate wines that are slightly outside of the box. Their estate grown and bottled Cabernets drink beautifully right out of the bottle and show great elegance and finesse.	
Cabernet Sauvignon, "Special Selection" Caymus Vineyards - Napa Valley 2013	250
The full-throttle character is here as expected with lots of ripe fruit and toasted oak, sage, and mint. Silky tannins; the ripe fruit dominates, it shows form and juiciness.	

Bordeaux Blend, Cain Five – St. Helena, California	2001 300 2006 275
Composed of the five classic varieties—Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot, Malbec, and Petit Verdot—Cain Five epitomizes the benefits of blending to achieve a complex wine. It is supple and rich of texture, combining a full, firm structure with a long and subtle finish.	
Red Blend, “Insignia” Joseph Phelps Winery – Napa Valley, California (375ml)	165
“Amazing aromas of blueberry, blackberry, mineral and bark. Complex nose. Full body plus super-integrated tannins with superb balance and depth. Coffee and chocolate too. Very long and mind-bending. A tribute to the vintage. Drink or hold. A long life ahead of it” – <i>James Suckling</i> 97pts.	
Red Blend, "Ampersand" Levy & McClellan - Napa Valley, California	350
From the winemaker of Harlan and his wife Martha McClellan, the winemaker at Sloan, comes a Bordeaux Blend that puts the old world to task. Subtle, elegant, and refined, this showcases each grape individually as well as the star package they combine together to become.	
Red Blend, Opus One – Napa Valley	350
This quintessential California red wine never fails to impress. Full of mouth filling fruit and terroir, to drink this is to truly experience classic Napa style.	
Red Blend, “Mad Hatter” Dancing Hares Vineyard – Napa Valley	125
Aromatically flamboyant, one can take note of each varietal on its own: the powerful fruit of Cabernet Sauvignon, licorice spice and savory notes from Cabernet Franc, Merlot’s juicy blue fruits and the dark, brooding nature of Petit Verdot.	
Cabernet Sauvignon, Bone Ash Vineyard, Venge – Napa Valley, California	160
Jelly jar, concentrated black fruit and polished tannin abound in this Estate grown and bottled wine.	
Bordeaux Blend, "Papillon" Orin Swift Cellars - Napa Valley, California	125
Dense and rich with polished tannin. Black fruit gives way to cedar, smoke, and a long finish.	
Cabernet Sauvignon, Cakebread Cellars – Napa Valley, California	120
Beautiful black and blue fruits abound, and the wine is structured and vibrant. A classic Cabernet.	
Red Blend, Dancing Hares Vineyard – Napa Valley	225
Mocha, chocolate, and marinated cherries breathe out a vibrancy and aromatic brightness laces with notes of incense, graphite, and toasted oak with seductive, highly polished tannin.	
Cabernet Sauvignon, Levy & McClellan - Napa Valley	700
The personal bottling of Bob Levy from Harlan Vineyards, this is a forthright, beautiful expression of Cabernet from one of the most sought after vintners in the US. Very small production and high allocation makes this wine hard to get but so worth it!	
Saint-Emillion Grand Cru, Ch. Grand Barrail Lamarzelle Figeac – Bordeaux, France	95
This is a traditional, classy expression of Bordeaux from the Right Bank.	
Barolo, Marvenga – Piedmonte, Italy	65
Classic notes of leather and clove with a thoughtful structure make this wine a lovely addition to any meal.	
Brunello di Montalcino Riserva, Mate - Toscana, Italy	115
A red that delivers beautiful rose bush, dried meat, strawberry, and sea salt character. It's full-bodied, with firm and silky tannins and a long and intense finish.	

Amarone delle Valpolicella Classico, Villa Marin – Veneto, Italy 85
Intense fruit with a rich, bold character of candied plums and tobacco.

Amarone delle Valpolicella Classico, Cesari – Veneto, Italy 100
A firm structure and dusty terroir make this fabulous expression of Amarone shine.

Primitivo, “1921” Varvaglione – Puglia, Italy 120
Juicy and exciting, this wine has a rustic structure that is balanced by rich fruit.

Chef David's Private Collection

Cabernet Sauvignon – Old Vine, M SQUARED – Calistoga, California 225
Draped over the terraced slopes of Mt. Pisgah, the Monte Rosso Vineyard basks in the sun above the fog line of the Valley of the Moon. The vines were planted by Louis M. Martini in 1937 and are some of the oldest Cabernet vines being worked to date. Michael Martini is the winemaker and hand crafts this wine with the legacy of his family in mind.

Cabernet Sauvignon, “Reserve”, Cade Winery – Howell Mountain, California 350
“The Cabernet Sauvignon Reserve comes in a unique bottle that is similar to the special bottle used by Joseph Phelps for their Insignia (which reminds me of a grenade). A blockbuster superstar, this inky/purple-hued 2012 is filled with crème de cassis, blueberry and mulberry fruit that hides any notion of its oak aging. Opulent, voluptuously textured, multilayered and stunningly rich with a finish that lasts 45+ seconds, this magnificent Cabernet should age effortlessly for two decades or more. But who can wait that long? Not me.” – *Robert Parker* 98pts.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Silver Oak – Napa Valley 2011 200
An elegant representation of Napa Valley Cabernet from a cool vintage. Flavors of vanilla, coffee beans and raspberries are buttressed by dusty tannin, firm acidity, and a mouth coating texture.

Amarone delle Valpolicella Riserva, “Bosan” Cesari – Veneto, Italy 2006 160
This concentrated wine offers aromas of tobacco leaf, stewed plum, grilled porcini mushroom and sage. The lush palate delivers blackberry extract layered with notes of chocolate and vanilla alongside velvety, embracing tannins.

Barolo Riserva, “1752” Riserva, Damilano – Cannubi Hill, Piedmonte, Italy 2008 350
A wine born with the idea that this, in particular, represents the essence of Cannubi. Supple and powerful, it is a true testament to old-world wine making.

Brunello di Montalcino Riserva, Argiano – Tuscany, Italy 2010 300
Only made in the best vintages, this wine veers toward the international and modern style of the spectrum. The bouquet peels back to reveal black cherry and currant. This wine offers exquisite texture with firm tannins that are balanced against the soft plushness of the fruit. - *Robert Parker* 96pts

Cabernet Sauvignon, The Vineyard House – Napa Valley, California

Jeremy Nickel's homage to his father Gil, this Cabernet is an explosion of well-structured fruit and dried flowers. The overall experience is a bit of a conundrum as the wine has noticeable tannin yet remains soft and lingers on the palate. Gil Nickel founded Far Niente, Nickel & Nickel, and Dolce where his son Jeremy assisted in the winemaking. He passed away from cancer, and in his memory 10% of all sales go to cancer research.
