PARKING is available for \$6 (cash only). Surface parking is available on the south side of the auditorium and can be accessed from the west side of the building. Barrier-free surface parking is located on the ground floor of the Car Park. We recommend you arrive at least one hour prior to showtime to avoid long parking lineups.

PUBLIC TRANSIT [Edmonton Transit](#) offers an easy and convenient way to travel to your favourite events. Catch the Clareview Train (if traveling north) or the Century Park Train (if traveling south). The LRT stop is located on 114th Street at the "Health Sciences/Jubilee Station."
