PUBLIC TRANSIT

[Calgary Transit](#) offers an easy and convenient way to travel to your favourite events. Catch the Tuscany C-Train (if traveling north) or the Somerset/Bridlewood C-Train (if travelling south). The C-Train stop is located immediately behind the building at the "SAIT/ACAD/Jubilee Station."

PARKING

The parking rate for Alberta Ballet performances at the Southern Alberta Jubilee Auditorium is \$7.00 per performance. Payment can be made at the pay stations by credit card, cash (exact change is required, change cannot be dispensed). You can also avoid the line-up at the playstation by using the new smartphone app: HangTag (available on Google Play and the App Store).
