Survey weighted to match expected turnout demographics for the 2018 General Election. Margin of Error is +/- 3.6%. Totals do not always equal 100% due to rounding. Margins of Error within specific demographics (crosstabs) is significantly higher due to smaller sample size. Survey conducted by Remington Research Group on behalf of Missouri Scout.
