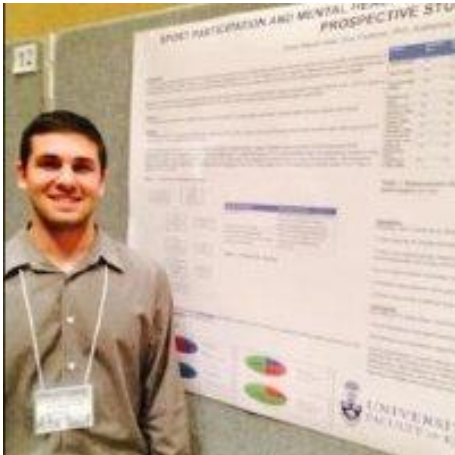

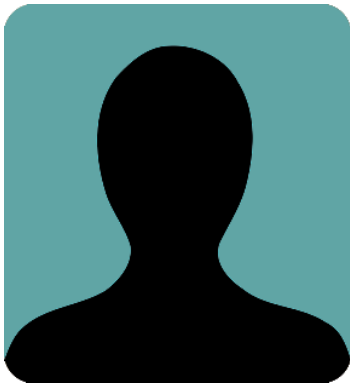
Diana Ahmed
