Short Biography

Erin Hunt is the Program Coordinator at Mines Action Canada. She has been working in humanitarian disarmament in various capacities since 2006 and doing public education on the Ottawa Treaty banning landmines since 2003.

Erin's areas of expertise include the humanitarian impact of landmines and cluster munitions as well as the Ottawa Treaty, the Convention on Cluster Munitions, ongoing diplomatic efforts to prohibit autonomous weapons systems (killer robots) and nuclear weapons. Erin was a member of the civil society negotiating team focusing on positive obligations during the 2017 process to negotiate the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons with the Nobel Peace Laureate International Campaign to Abolish Nuclear Weapons.

Erin has a master's degree in Human Security and Peacebuilding from Royal Roads University.
