Short Biography

Nauroz Tanya is a Kurdish-Canadian composer, started music lessons from age of six, his father was one of the pioneers in theater/early television revolution, and through him Nauroz grew a great interest in music and art. He successfully finished his degree in compositions from Wilfrid Laurier University. He composed music for Chamber ensembles, piano solo, full orchestra, and short and full-length movies; showcased in Europe, Australia, US, and Canada.

He wrote music for media and television in France, Germany, and Sweden where he lived for several years and attended the Academy of Music and Drama in Gothenburg. He worked as an assistant administrator for Guelph Symphony and Administrator for Guelph youth Symphony Orchestra. He studied piano with Dr. Joseph Ferretti, and composition with Dr. Glenn Buhr, and currently with Linda Catlin Smith. Away from his medical studies, Nauroz continue composing, most recently his first piano concerto were premiered with Wilfrid Laurier Symphony Orchestra conducted by Daniel Bartholomew-Poyser , his later compositions are more focused on the issue of immigration, and diaspora.
