### ONGOING VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES:

**Mentors (3:30-4:30; 4:30-5:30 or both; one day per week): ADULTS & HS STUDENTS**

Choose one day per week (Monday through Thursday) to serve as a mentor and assist an elementary school child with their homework weekly. You will be matched with a child and visit with that same child weekly. Full school year commitment required. Can co-mentor with a friend on alternate weeks if weekly is too difficult of a requirement.

### ONGOING DONE-IN-A-DAY OPPORTUNITIES

**Volunteer Book Club (throughout the year—most Friday's available from 3:30-5pm): ADULTS & HS STUDENTS**

Join us on Friday's to read childhood favorites (Dr. Seuss, Mother Goose, etc.) to a small group of Kindergarten, 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> grade students for one hour. Volunteer readers must plan a follow-up activity to accompany the book. Follow up activities include arts & craft activities, games, etc.

**Corporate Kickball (Fridays; 3pm-5:00 pm): ADULTS ONLY**

Get a group of your co-workers together for a fun afternoon away from the office playing kickball with our students!

**Fun Friday in the Field (Fridays; 3pm-5:00 pm): ADULTS ONLY**

Pick an age group and plan a few outdoor activities for them! Our kids love learning new games, so get creative!

**Artsy Afternoon (Fridays; 3pm-5:00 pm): ADULTS AND HS GROUPS**

Do you love arts and crafts? Share your talents with our kids! Pick an age group and spend an afternoon crafting with them.

### COMMUNITY DRIVES

**Back to School Drive (Preferred Drop Off by: August 7, 2017; accepted all year)**

Host a supply drive at your business, place of worship, country club, etc. All donated supplies will be used to promote academic achievement at our after school program. Items needed include clear or mesh backpacks, notebook paper, notebooks, posters, copy paper (both white and colored), pencils, jump drives (any size) and other miscellaneous school and art supplies.

**Thanksgiving Drive (Partner pick-up dates are November 17 & 20; drop off at MWYF November 16 & 17 by 3pm)**

Organize a drive for canned goods, packaged goods and other perishables which will be distributed to low income students of the Malivai Washington Youth Foundation. Or collect funds to purchase gift cards that can be used for perishables such as turkeys, milk, eggs, and more!
