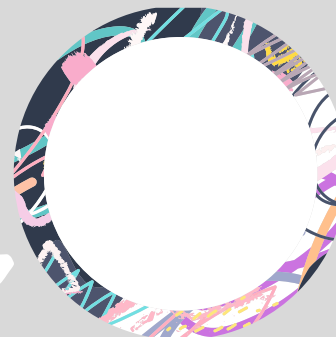


My Revision

Map: Whatever outlining or planning or organizations looks like for you and your process is your map - including your drafts. Courting Flow and Orient will show up here.

Chariot: These are the elements of writing and process that drive the story for you and keep you moving forward. Look at Flow and Explore for more ideas.

Navigators: Your process is your #1 navigational system. Who or what else helps you keep your eyes on your North Star?
