She has appeared in LSO's Rattle festival, LSO discovery concerts, LSO On Track and other many concerts with LSO players in Barbican hall, St, Luke's.

As an orchestral musician, she has worked with Valery Gergiev, Tadaaki Otaka, Kazufumi Yamashita and performed in Suntory Hall, Tokyo Metropolitan Theatre, Tokyo bunka Kaikan, Sumida Triphony hall, Muza Kawasaki Symphony Hall in Japan.
