Dear Coconino County Educator,

Coconino County Parks and Recreation would like to invite you and your students to attend the 2017 Coconino County Fair, **Labor Day Weekend, September 1 – 4**, on the Fairgrounds at Fort Tuthill County Park in Flagstaff, AZ.

We realize that it is expensive to take field trips so, to offset your costs, we are continuing to offer the Coconino County Fair **Schools Day on Friday, September 1**. All students and required chaperones will receive FREE entry into the Fair on this day while accompanied with their school. In an effort to make the process more uniform and streamlined, we ask that the program participants are made aware of the guidelines, outlined below.

Below are the chaperone per student ratios, included in the free admission:

- Pre-school - Kindergarten = 1 chaperone per 5 students
- Grades 1 - 3 = 1 chaperone per 5 students
- Grades 4 and up = 1 chaperone per 8 students
- Home School = 1 chaperone per 4 students

Any additional chaperones must purchase admissions at the gate or online at <https://www.coconinocountyfair.com>.

**Schools interested in participating in Schools Day must pre-register. No walk-up registrations will be accepted.** Check-In will start at **9:30 a.m.** and Schools Day goes until 2:00 p.m. Enclosed you will find a pre-registration form for each classroom to fill out and return to Coconino County Parks and Recreation **before Monday, August 21**. Homeschool groups may be asked to furnish additional identification upon check-in. Schools Day check-in is at the main entrance to the fairgrounds. You will find a map with the new entrance location and bus loading/parking.

We will have a Scavenger Hunt activity sheet available upon your arrival. Classes that complete the Scavenger Hunt and turn it in afterwards have a chance to win a pizza party for your class. Good luck and happy learning!
