

# QUESTIONS FOR CLASSROOM

## Classroom Conversation Guide

### Part 1 : God's Love

#### 1. God Loves So Many Things

- Ask the kids to repeat after you: *The most important part of the story is that God loves so many things.*
- Catechism Question: “What is the most important part of the story?”
  - Answer: “The most important part of the story is that God loves so many things.”
- Ask: “What is your favorite place to go? What is a place in this world that you think is beautiful?”
  - Give the kids some time to share. Ask some followup questions
    - “...And what do you like about that place, Jennifer?” (for example)
- “When we were using our imagination to fly to different parts of the world and seeing differing beautiful things, is there any place that you have heard of in the world that you wanted to go to?”
  - Again, give them time to share.
- Talk about how we don't know how God created the world, but the bible describes it as God SPEAKING things into existence. He said, “Let there be birds....and there were birds.”
- “Why do you think there are so many beautiful things on Earth?”
  - Here—try to guide the conversation toward God's creation being a gift to us. That the beauty of God's creation demonstrates God's presence.
- Encourage the kids to draw a picture of one of the scenes

- from the story (the field of flowers, the forest, etc).
- Remind the kids that God LOVES his creation. That there are so many things that God loves.
