## ABOUT THE TEXAS SCULPTURE GARDEN

A four-acre tract of land at the entrance to HALL Park was reserved as a special tribute to Texas artists and their work. Designed with lakes, water features, native landscaping and walking trails, the outdoor portion of the Texas Sculpture Garden surrounds the lake just outside the 6801 Gaylord Parkway building. The collection continues inside the building's lobby.

## ABOUT CRAIG & KATHRYN HALL AND THE HALL COLLECTION AT HALL PARK

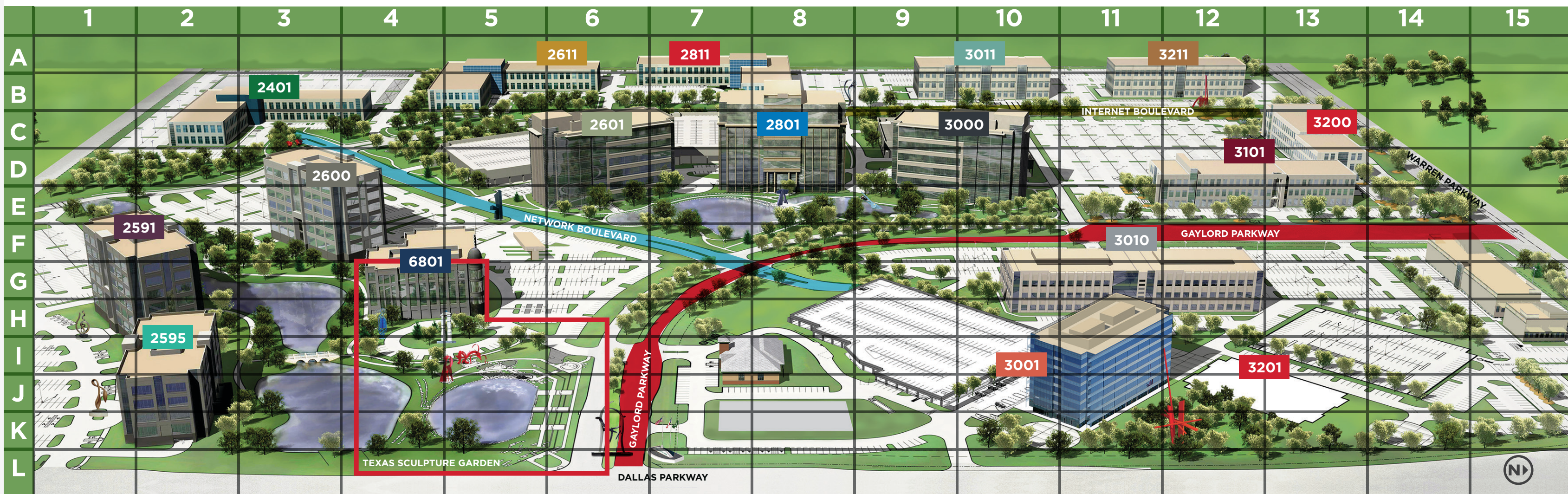
