





MANUSCRIPT & DISSERTATION S.O.S.

THE SITUATION:

My last dissertation client and I worked together intensely for 4 months leading up to their defense.

I was a last-minute hire and they had been struggling for years to find the time/will power to finish their dissertation— they had all the research, but really hadn't thought through a unifying thesis statement and narrative arc to how it was implemented throughout their dissertation.

SOLUTIONS:

We started with their first chapter, and worked our way through the subsequent chapters. Then, we worked on the introduction and conclusion simultaneously to ensure the argumentation was book-ended. Their Achilles' heel was introductions, so we saved those for last. I made "cheat sheets" for each chapter that bullet-pointed their most important threads and arguments. This way, when it came time to work on that dreaded intro/conclusion, we had a fill-in-the-blank scenario going on.
