Option A Day Use Only

\$300 per day

- Use of main hall, ablutions, BBQ & kitchen area
- No minimum or maximum number of guests
- Chairs & tables, if required, can be provided. Please indicate your requirements at the time of booking
- A white board is available for use
- All other stationary items, including projectors, to be provided by the guests, unless prior arrangements made with the college. Please note that this may incur additional costs.

Option B Accommodation & Full Facility Use

**\$26 per person per day, or
\$800 per night for larger groups**

- Use of dorms, main hall, ablutions, BBQ & kitchen area
- Minimum of 15 guests, unless by prior arrangement
- Maximum of 40 guests, unless by prior arrangement
- Dormitory style accommodation; mattresses and bed linen will be provided. Guests are welcome to bring their own doona, sleeping bag and pillow should they so wish
- Chairs & tables in the main hall, if required, can be provided. Please indicate your requirements at the time of booking. A white board is also available for use
- All other stationary items, including projectors, to be provided by the guests, unless prior arrangements made with the college. Please note that this may incur additional costs.
- Please note that a \$500 bond will be charged at the time of booking and refunded to guests on departure, provided no damage to the facility has been incurred during the stay

Option C Camping Only

\$10 per person per day

- Use of camping area & long drop toilets only
- No minimum or maximum number of guests
- Guests to provide their own camping equipment

Option D Camping with Showers

\$15 per person per day

- Use of camping area & ablution block
- Minimum of 4 guests, no maximum number of guests
- Guests to provide their own camping equipment

Catering and Transport Options

- It is assumed that most guests will be self-catering or bring in their own catering for events and conferences. However, the college is able to supply catering of cold food items only (morning tea, lunch & afternoon tea) from \$45 per person per day. Please contact the college to discuss options.
- It is also assumed that most guests will make their own way up to the centre. Please note that to access the centre a reasonably high clearance vehicle is required and a four-wheel-drive during wet weather. Should you require the use of a Djarragun bus or commuter with a Djarragun driver, please contact the college to discuss options; additional costs for this service will be incurred.
