
 The first book of the New Testament looks at the life and teachings of Jesus Christ in this 22 week Bible study.



Genesis — Look at creation through the lens of science, and the lives of Adam and Eve, Noah, Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, in this 22 chapter study.



Study the first gospel written, recounting the life and ministry of Jesus in this 18 week study.




Moses and the Torah —


Study Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, and Deuteronomy in this 22 chapter book completing the Pentateuch.




21 week study begins with the infancy narratives and early life of Jesus and continues to the Ascension of Our Lord.



Acts and Letters — Explore the early Church through Luke's Acts of the Apostles and Paul's letters in this 22 week Bible study.






Romans and Ephesians —

This 22 week study covers two beloved Pauline prison epistles: Romans and Ephesians, to provide deep and profound theological insights.




The Gospel of John — Study the life of Jesus from John's theological perspective, and see the sacraments emerge in this 21 week study.




David and the Psalms —
