Public Forum Cancelled

Please note that the public forum scheduled for Thursday 2 April at 7.30pm at the Australian Centre for Christianity and Culture in Canberra has been cancelled due to the COVID-19 virus.

Concerned Catholics Canberra Goulburn Chair, Emeritus Professor John Warhurst AO made the announcement today in line with current health advice.

Professor Warhurst said CCCG is investigating other options for sharing the wisdom and expertise of the presenters in the lead up to the 2020 Plenary Council in Australia, which is scheduled for later this year.

‘My sincere thanks to each of the presenters who have already committed significant time to the preparation of the discussion papers for consideration ahead of the forum.

‘In the meantime, I invite you to read those background papers which are available on the CCCG [website](#).

‘We will keep you posted about upcoming events and opportunities for discussion at this important point in the Church’s history,’ Professor Warhurst said.
