Background

Our Archbishop and other Plenary Council Members from the Canberra-Goulburn region are aware of this lay-led initiative. The Convocation will be presented by prominent and thoughtful lay Catholic leaders, and will bring a tighter focus to the Plenary Council as we drew nearer to the first session in early October, addressing issues that matter, including:

- hearing the voice of the people in our Church;
- deepening connections with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander traditions;
- Australian Plenary Council in its international context;
- inclusion particularly ensuring the equality of women;
- synodality and governance.

In May 2021, Sr Joan Chittister OSB addressed the 1st ACCCR Convocation with 3,000+ participants.

However, a large proportion of Catholics in the Catholic Archdiocese of Canberra & Goulburn was not given the opportunity to learn of that historic and uplifting gathering.

Given Pope Francis' resolve on synodality, and our own Archbishop's recent <u>Pastoral Letter</u> on mutual listening we are confident that all Catholics in our Archdiocese will be given adequate notice to learn of this 2nd ACCCR Convocation, two weeks from now.
