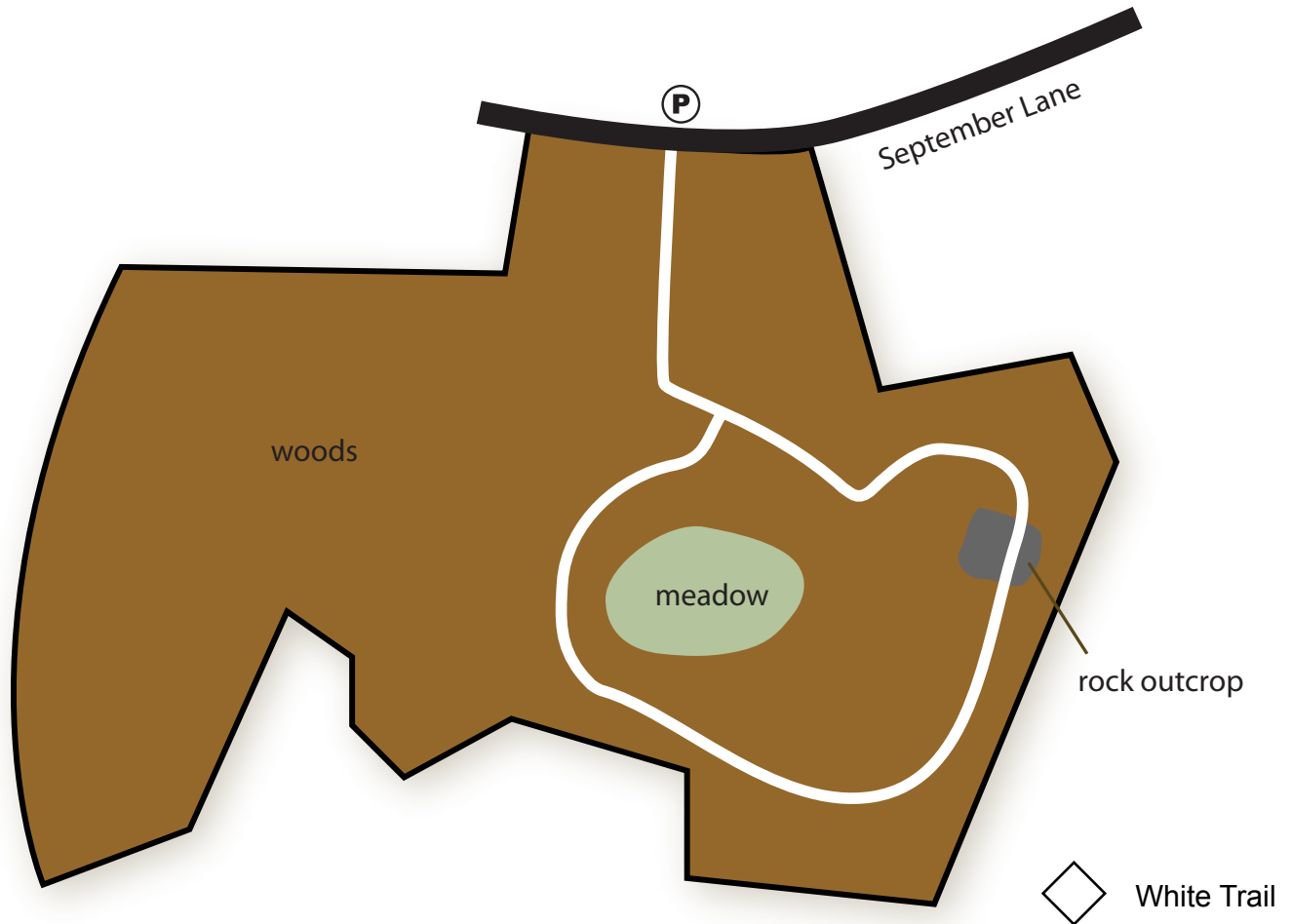


# LeGallienne Bird Sanctuary

12.5 acres



**Notes:** The trail, occasionally steep, is about a mile long as it crisscrosses the hillside through sparse woodlands, over a small meadow, by several unusual rock outcroppings, and, of special note, the large boulder Ms. LeGallienne used to practice for her Broadway role as Peter Pan. Occasional rock piles on the hillside mark the former sites of barns or houses and indicating the probability of subsistence farming.

**Historical Nugget:** Ms. LeGallienne wrote that her home was more than 200 years old when she bought it in 1926. Her move "To this haven... helped me sustain my physical and spiritual energy... that there was not a day when one is not overwhelmed by the beauty..."

**Location:** North on Weston Road (State Route 57) past Center; left at flashing light; up hill a half mile, turn right on Hillside North; then left on September Lane. Trail entrance through opening in split rail fence on right. Park along the road.
