





Caring for Your Plants

Fiddle Leaf Fig **TROPICAL**

- 💧 Let your fiddle dry between waterings, but then give it a good soak. This varies, but for a 4" to 6" pot, water once or twice a week; for a 10" pot, water every 7-10 days; or for a 12" pot or bigger, water every 10-14 days.
- ☀️ Bright light! Fiddles thrive with a bit of morning or evening sun but avoid mid-day sun (11 a.m. to 3 p.m.). Try south or west facing windows!
- 💡 Fiddles tell you if they are over or under watered. Check the leaves, if the edges turn brown, it means they're too dry. If black splotches appear, that means too much water. Try a moisture reader to maintain proper moisture.



Rosemary **HERB**

- 💧 Water a couple times a week when you first plant it, and after that keep moist, but don't let it sit in water. If planted outside, no need to water.
- ☀️ Partial sun! A cold-hardy plant, it does well in your yard and it will thrive year round.
- 💡 Use rosemary for cooking, for aromatherapy, and as a bug deterrent!



Snake Plant **TROPICAL**

- 💧 As one of the lowest water (and light) requiring plants, this plant is stylish and really easy. For a 4" pot, water every couple weeks or for a 6 to 8" pot, water once a month.
- ☀️ Low light! Snake plants thrive in low to no light but can adapt to brighter areas.
- 💡 Snake plants don't like cold or moisture on the leaves, so don't mist them, especially in the winter! As a bonus, they naturally purify the air.



Juniper **BONSAI**

- 💧 Most people go wrong not keeping junipers wet enough, so get a spray bottle and mist leaves between waterings (water every other day).
- ☀️ Bright light! Juniper needs good sunshine, so set right in a window or outside where it will get sun.
- 💡 Juniper is a cold-hardy plant, so you can grow it inside or out, and it will survive the winter!



Cactus **SUCCULENT**

- 💧 Make sure to not overwater, especially if they are not in bright sun. For a 2" to 4" pot, water once a week; for a 6" to 8" pot, water every couple weeks; for 10" pot, water once a month.
- ☀️ Full sun! While they do best in full sun (kept right in the windowsills), they can handle bright light instead.
- 💡 In the wintertime, water only once or twice. This is where many people go wrong and their succulents rot during colder months.



Venus Fly Trap **CARNIVOROUS**

- 💧 Fly traps need to stay moist at all times, so plant in moss, which holds more moisture than dirt. Also, try a container that doesn't drain or set down in a saucer of water.
- ☀️ Bright light! Fly traps need a good window — don't put in the middle of the house with no light; it will turn yellow or black.
- 💡 Don't use city or chlorinated water, because it will dry it out the plant.



Yucca **SUCCULENT**

- 💧 The summer is the most important time for watering yucca; it's their growing season. Otherwise, water once a week.
- ☀️ Full light! They are resilient in outdoor flower beds.
- 💡 Yuccas sleep in the winter, so hold back on water so they don't rot!



Citrus **FRUIT BEARING**

- 💧 Keep moist but well drained. In springtime, you can water once or twice a week but in summertime, you want to water every couple days. If potted, move inside in the winter.
- ☀️ Bright light! Citrus plants require 4-6 hours of direct sun per day in order to produce fruit.
- 💡 Fertilization is key! Often, people delay fertilization until planting the tree in the ground, but it's really important to give citrus those nutrients, especially in the spring.



Chinese Penny Plant **SUCCULENT**

- 💧 Let them dry out fully before watering and be careful not to overwater. For a 2" to 4" pot, water once a week; for 6" to 8," every couple weeks; or for a 10" pot, water once a month.
- ☀️ Bright light!
- 💡 Penny plants don't like the cold or humidity! Check the leaves, if they turn yellow that means too much water and too little sun.
