Ground, Air Hunt by Patrol, Police Nets Theft Suspects

Officers on the ground and in the air from state and local law-enforcement agencies captured a pair of burglary suspects Thursday afternoon following a four-hour chase in southwest Oklahoma City.

William Boyd Jay, 26, of 1912 S Central, and Michael Richard Shepard, 16, of 1112 SW 16, were wanted in connection with burglary and unauthorized use of a motor vehicle.

The manhunt began about 10:30 a.m. when City Biologist of 710 S Choctaw Road, was working in his yard and noticed an illegal pickup truck in front of the house.

Police said witnesses went into his house and got a 28-cylinder engine and allegedly saw Shepard in the rear.

Victim Led 'Difficult Life,' Police Say

By Mark D. Green Police investigators said they turned up an insignificant breakthrough in their probe of the slaying death of a 22-year-old Oklahoma City woman whose severed head was found Wednesday.

Background information about the victim, Arley Ann Killian, indicates she led a difficult life characterized by trouble at home.

Typically, she spent much of her time simply wandering the streets, according to officers who picked her up in southwest Oklahoma City a month ago.

Detectives Wednesday identified the victim, using dental records and fingerprints taken from a hair which, along with the woman's head and silver portions of her body, was recovered April 19 in the 348 block of SW 16.

At 4:15 p.m. the woman was found by her father, Eddie Killian Jr., who is now serving a 30-year sentence at the state penitentiary in McAlester, Okla., officials said.

He also has been convicted of assault with a deadly weapon and battery, officials said.

Killian spent time at Central State Hospital on numerous occasions because of problems which developed from post-natal illness.

Although she attended school through the senior high level, family members said Miss Killian never developed any career interests.

Officers Bill Hyler and Ron Houck said they once took the woman home early on the morning of April 22 after they spotted her standing near SW 2 and Central.

"She took her home to keep her from getting lost," Hyler said. "She said she always wanted home that way and wanted south down Central across the tracks," he said. "She told us she was 17."

Hyler said Miss Killian was found in jail Wednesday as an escapee from the hospital.

Detectives are trying to locate the woman's friend and acquaintance with the severed head, with the information about the woman in contact in investigations at 228-3111.
