







My work is an ongoing search for a personal solution to what separates me from everyone else. It is that search that ignites my desire to create.

My work may veer away from the easy, the comfortable, but it is my sense that the work should draw upon what is real in the world, even if it means the work is unsettling—or disturbing.

On the surface, this series falls back on some familiar themes and figures from some of my earlier works, but I am also responding to an urgent pull to address the rise of technology and the fall of nature. My perspective is less concerned with robots becoming more human, and more with the fact that humans are becoming more robotic.

With the guidance and teachings of a sculptural apprenticeship in his grandfather's workshop, along with training at the Museum School in Boston and beyond at the Rhode Island School of Design and the Massachusetts College of Art, Enrico V. Pinardi emerged as a leading figure among celebrated Boston painters, sculptors, and draftsmen. Pinardi's work reflects the heritage of early 20th century surrealism while showcasing a minimalistic approach, trompe l'oeil style, and creative skill across several media. Throughout his prolific career, Pinardi produced a series of paintings and sculptures dealing with both the dream world and the viewer's consciousness by integrating art historical and religious symbols into his own experiences. Pinardi has developed an individual style that honors, builds upon, and establishes new modes of dealing with the subconscious.




