### **JOB DESCRIPTION:**

The **Meal Exchange App Developer** will work with the Meal Exchange national network and their campus community to develop an app to assist with volunteer recruitment and management. The Meal Exchange App Developer will finalize prototyping of the Trick or Eat web and mobile applications for a launch during the 2018 campaign at the University of Guelph. Students will connect with a variety of stakeholders on campus and from across Canada.

### **Job Roles:**

- Finalize app prototypes including, but not limited to, developing and testing participant and administrator use cases (e.g. create an event/account/team, manage routes, generate reports), developing an AODA compliant web and mobile user interface, and testing algorithms that assign teams to routes
- Support the final implementation at Trick or Eat 2018
- Provide Institutional Memory and Summary of App for future development
