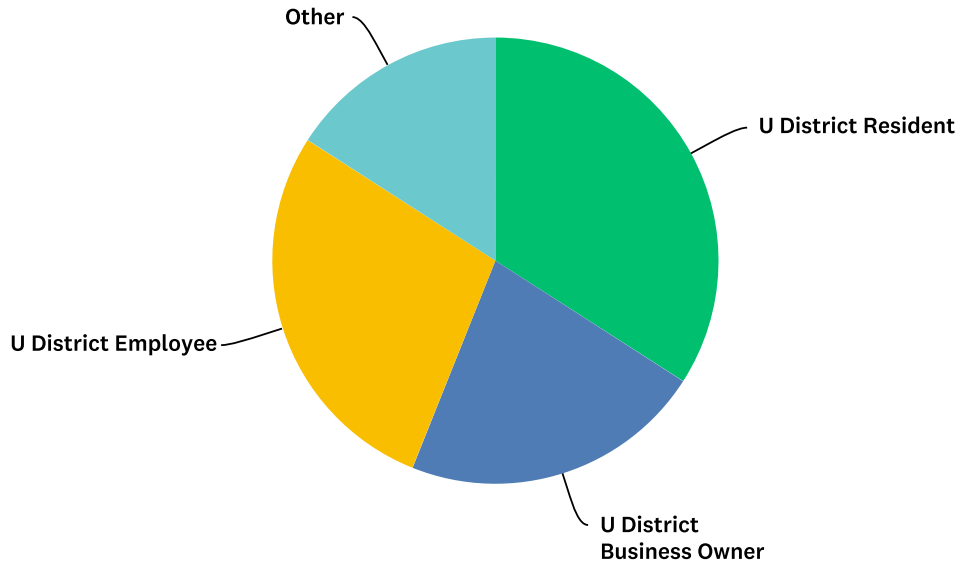


# Q1 What is your connection to the U District?

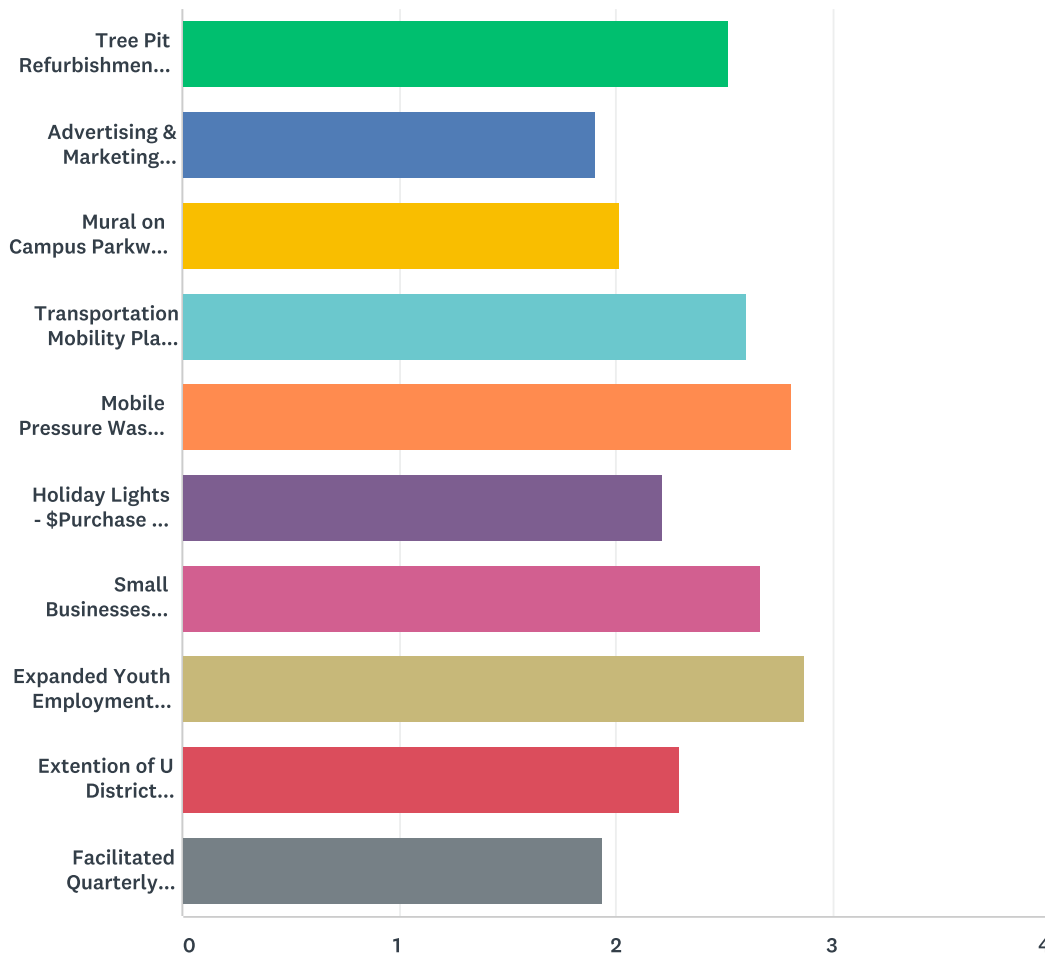
