

WR100 Extra Credit Writing Assignment Sheet

For extra credit this semester, you will have the opportunity to attend a reading, lecture, or event and write a structured reflection using the following questions as a guide. You should write around 250 words (about one page double-spaced using Times New Roman font). When you're finished with your reflection, upload it to Dropbox in the folder named "Extra Credit."

What?

What was the main point of the lecture or the purpose of the event? What happened?

So What?

What did you find meaningful about the lecture or event?

Now What?

What do you plan to do in the future to *apply* the new knowledge you gained from the lecture or event? For example, if you attended a fiction or poetry reading, you may have been inspired to reflect and discern more about something in your life or in the world around you and write about it. Or if you attended an event that featured a panel on health access or the digital divide in Baltimore, how do you plan to transition your knowledge into action? Will you get involved with service-learning at Loyola? Will you volunteer more in your faith community back home? In the words of St. Ignatius, explain how you're going to *go fort and set the world on fire*.
