3. If you (the donor) chooses an action that is above the credit amount they have, then the credit(s) will be added to other donors votes to achieve the desired volunteer action.
4. If you (the donor) chooses an action that is below the credit amount they have, then each credit will account to multiple instances of the volunteer action.
5. Submit your Good Deed Credit selection and follow us the ensure we volunteer on your behalf!
