Lauded for her "flowering, darkly rich voice" (Boston Classical Review) and "natural, easy stage presence, and ample vocal gift", mezzo-soprano **Krista Marie Laskowski** is "adding an engaging zest" to the American opera and concert stage. Ms. Laskowski was most recently seen performing the role of Amanda in a new production, OUT Loud, with Opera Tampa. Earlier this year, she covered Orlofsky in Die Feldermaus at Gulfshore Opera and in 2022 she performed in a series of concerts along Florida's Gulf Coast, including engagements in

Tampa, Sarasota, Siesta Key, Punta Gorda, Naples and Marco Island.

Ms. Laskowski earned her Master and Bachelor of Music at Indiana University Jacobs School of Music. Her repertoire includes both standard and contemporary opera, musical theatre, oratorio and song. She debuted at Indianapolis Opera as Flora Bervoix in Verdi's La Traviata, and her portrayal of the Marquise de Merteuil in the Boston premiere of Conrad Susa's The Dangerous Liaisons was noted "flamboyantly evil in a way that's so very fun to watch" (New England Theatre Geek). Additional performances include Meg March (Little Women), Siebel (Faust), Amastre (Serse), Florence Pike (Albert Herring), La Ciesca (Gianni Schicchi), Olga (Die lustige Witwe), The Witch (Hänsel and Gretel) and Franca Nacarelli (The Light in the Piazza). Her work on the concert stage includes the works of Bach, Vivaldi, Saint-Saëns, Vaughan Williams and Argento. Additional credits include Odyssey Opera, Opera Tampa, Gulfshore Opera, Boston Opera Collaborative, MassOpera, and New Voices Opera.

What a treat it will be for such an accomplished, gifted artist to join us at our January 12th FRIENDS meeting. Be sure to mark your calendar and not miss this opportunity.


