VOTE!

PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES CAN CALL DISABILITY RIGHTS CONNECTICUT TO FIND OUT:

- If you are a registered voter.
- How to become a registered voter.
- Where your polling place is located.
- How to obtain transportation to your polling place.
- How to obtain accommodations in order to vote (i.e., filling out a ballot on a computer, bringing a service animal).
- How to file complaints if a polling place is physically inaccessible.
- More information about voting rights.

Your Rights Are:

- You may see a ballot in advance.
- You may register and vote on the same day.
- You may get a new ballot if you make a mistake.
- You may leave some choices blank on the ballot.
- You may receive disability-related accommodations.
