Sign up for our Scrip program today!

Whenever you purchase through the Scrip program, your rebate/credits from the prior month will be applied to your monthly tuition. For example, your October Scrip Rebate will be applied/credited to your November monthly tuition. These credits will be applied/refunded to your account. For each purchase you make using the Scrip program, 85% of the Scrip Rebate you receive will be deducted from your monthly tuition. For example, if your Scrip Rebate for the month of October is \$20.00, \$17.00 will be deducted from your November tuition & \$3.00 (15%) will go to Light of Life.
