Below is a visual representation of safety statistics in North Central & Hillside North, the City of Troy, and Rensselaer County.

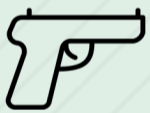
VIOLENT CRIME

COUNTY AND CAPITAL REGION STATISTICS



Violent crime decreased 11.7% across the Capital Region from 2009 to 2013.



Property crime decreased 8.3% across the Region during the same time period.



The Capital Region has seen a **15.5% increase in the number of drug-related arrests** between 2000 and 2014.



Rensselaer County had an **increase of 37% in drug-related arrests** between 2000 and 2014.

COMMUNITY POLICE

Trespass Affidavit Program - available to property owners who are having trouble with illegal activity in their building(s).

Nuisance Abatement Program - makes property owners aware of nuisances within their buildings.

Narcotics Eviction Program - If drug-related search warrant/arrests take place, property owners are directed by the District Attorney to institute eviction proceedings.

School Resource Officers/COPS in Schools - Community Police has one officer primarily assigned to each of the two school districts (Troy and Lansingburgh).

Child Seat Install and Inspection - installation and inspection of child seats, as well as distribution of free child safety seats for eligible residents.

Landlord Training - education for landlords on their rights and how to become more effective at managing properties.
