Key pointers to get beads out of the furniture:

Best option: If the beads are already in an interior liner – hopefully that’s your case – you can just ship them in the liner

Where is the best place to remove bean bag beans?

Tile or linoleum floors are the best surfaces for this task. These floor types make for easy cleaning once you’re finished (more on that later). Prepare such a surface by taking the time to clean in advance.

Prepare your bean removal tool kit – get this ready ahead of time. Things that you can’t remove beans without include:

TOOL KIT:

Some kind of tube. Roughly 25cm long and 10cm in diameter. You can make this from anything, including the body of a plastic bottle, or some poly pipe. This tube is what will ultimately help you remove and replace beads with minimal loss if necessary.

A funnel. Buy one of these or simply make your own from rolled up cardboard. You could even chop the top off a large plastic bottle to make this option work.

A handled vessel. A handled vessel such as a jug, pitcher, or mug can also prove beneficial for bringing ease to this process. With this to hand, you’ll merely need to scoop beans out of that bag casing, without the risks of a mess that can come from tubing solutions.

A large plastic bag. A large plastic bag is best here and should be around twice the size of your bean bag itself for the best possible ease of use.

Cleaning up after emptying bean bags

Cleaning up is often the most challenging process. Emptying bean bags with beans can result in tiny beads getting into places you never thought they could. Worse, it's vital to note that any stray beads can be dangerous when swallowed by humans or pets, as well as posing a significant choking hazard to any youngsters. But if you remove beans in a clean and well-prepared environment, clean up should be easy enough to manage with a vacuum cleaner.
