Tips for Warm Weather Motorcycle Riding

Spring and summer are on their way, and all of that sunshine makes for perfect motorcycle-riding weather. However, it can get pretty hot here in Southern California, which can translate into heat exhaustion and fatigue if you're not careful.

Know The Risks

The primary risks of riding in the heat are heatstroke, fatigue and dehydration. These risks can cause you to suffer from sunburns and exhaustion, and these can lead to heatstroke if you aren't careful. Dehydration can also cause these symptoms.

Stay Hydrated

Stay hydrated. You lose a great deal of water through sweat, and you'll need to replenish it. You will also want to replenish the salts and electrolytes that your body loses. Drink water and sports drinks on your ride, but stay away from caffeine, since it can be more dehydrating. You'll want to have some snacks to keep up your energy, too.

Take More Breaks

You should make sure that you're allowing your body some time to rest and regroup when it's hot outside. Trying to ride while you're sweating buckets and exhausted can be dangerous, since fatigue slows down your response time and may make you lose control of your bike. Take frequent breaks in shady or indoor areas. You can cool down, rest your muscles, drink some water, have a snack and stretch your legs so that you don't develop cramps.

Ride safe and enjoy your adventures. Looking forward to seeing you on our next meetings/rides.

If you have ideas for new riding locations or events feel free to suggest them with a chapter board member or road captain. We would love to hear them. All suggestions are definitely welcome.


