

**Shirley Ann Higuchi, Esq.:** Shirley currently leads the legal advocacy office of the American Psychological Association, where she manages a team of lawyers focused on legal and regulatory strategies to achieve optimal psychologist participation in a changing healthcare field. Shirley also chairs the Heart Mountain Wyoming Foundation, which memorializes the site where her parents were incarcerated during World War II. Active in the District of Columbia Bar, she was elected President of the Bar for 2003. In 2008, Shirley was appointed to the Judicial Tenure and Disabilities Commission for a 6-year term where she was responsible for reviewing misconduct, evaluating reappointments, and conducting fitness reviews of the District's judges. In 2014, Shirley was appointed to the Federal Law Enforcement Nominating Commission by Congresswoman Eleanor Holmes Norton (D-DC) which screens federal judges to be sent to the White House for approval.
