

## **BRUCE E. HOLLYWOOD**

Mr. Hollywood serves in the Deputy Directorate for Joint Strategic Planning in the Joint Staff J5. In this role, he is responsible for leading the development of the National Military Strategy, providing for the preparation and maintenance of relevant and integrated campaign and contingency plans, and assisting the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff in providing "Best Military Advice" to the Secretary of Defense and President. He works closely with interagency partners across the government to strengthen whole-of-government approaches to National Security challenges.

Prior to this assignment, Bruce was a Fellow in the initial cohort of the White House Leadership Development Program. Sponsored by the Executive Office of the President, the program is designed to build Enterprise Leaders to take on our Federal Government's highest priority and highest impact challenges. His assignment was focused on improving Service Member and Veterans Mental Health and suicide prevention services.

Bruce served 21 years in the United States Air Force in a wide range of operational, staff, and leadership positions and retired as a Colonel.

In addition to earning a Bachelor of Science and two Master of Science Degrees, he attended the Command and General Staff College at Ft Leavenworth, the Air War College at Maxwell AFB, and the Massachusetts Institute of Technology Seminar XXI program in Washington DC.
