# Humber Valley Art Club <u>Winter & Spring 2021</u>

Dear Members and Friends.

Our exciting new line-up of art workshops and classes for 2021 has arrived. The pandemic has kept us—temporarily—from our permanent home in Neilson Park. But, like a fresh white canvas, the year ahead holds promise, along with challenges—and a cause for celebration.

Humber Valley Art Club will mark its 70<sup>th</sup> anniversary in 2021. In June 1951, eight likeminded women set up their easels on the bank of the Humber River. Friendship and a passion for painting brought them together. But, over the next seven decades, it was resilience that kept the club's growing ranks together as their regular painting sessions moved from private homes to backyards, public parks and a church hall before settling into its current location in 1992.

HVAC's original founders would be surprised at the transformation of their club—now a successful non-profit that provides members with first-rate instruction in painting, printing and other arts in a congenial atmosphere in a spacious north-lit studio. But what hasn't changed is its members' resilience and adaptability. When a widespread lockdown against the coronavirus closed Neilson Park earlier this year, HVAC simply moved its workshops online, with the first one offered in August.

Membership continues to be required to participate in our classes and workshops. However, effective October  $1^{\rm st}$  2020, Long-distance students (those who live 100 km or more away) are not required to join as members in order to participate in our online offerings.

Members are welcome to take advantage of early registration for these online offerings, as well as many other benefits. <u>Members have priority registration until November 14<sup>th</sup></u>, then registration will open up to all.

Of course, HVAC will return to the studio when it is safe to do so, hopefully in September, but until then, programs will continue online. Happily, many of our favourite instructors have made the transition to Zoom. And, with challenge, comes opportunity. Our new virtual painting schedule allows us to "paint without borders."

# Online Classes and Workshops using Zoom

Our Classes and Workshops are fully interactive, meaning you can discuss and ask questions as if you were sitting together, gathered around a "live" demonstration. Class size is limited to allow for plenty of time for individual attention from the instructor. The moderator (host) will be available to help students with technical support if needed. If you are new to Zoom, your moderator will assist you, and you will be feeling comfortable in no time. You may choose to paint along with the instructor, or sit back and enjoy the entire demo before you start your painting. There will be ample opportunity to ask the instructor to look at your work and comment or makes suggestions after the demo.

A few days ahead of the scheduled class, you will receive the Zoom invitation and a "Welcome" letter with instructions, along with a materials list and photo references for each class.

To register for our Online offerings this Winter and Spring, please make your selections, then print off the attached registration form and mail it along with your cheque to Carol Essex, 66 Richland Crescent, Etobicoke, ON M9C- 4C3. Members will have priority registration until November 14<sup>th</sup>. Following that date, all registrations from both members and non-members will be welcome and processed in the order they are received. Class sizes are limited, so please don't delay.

We are delighted to bring you Fabio Cembranelli, an acclaimed international master artist, all the way from his home in Brazil. Fabio is renown for his uniquely intuitive approach to painting luminous, loose, vibrant watercolours.

In this "live" and interactive workshop you will see and learn how "timing" plays such an important role in achieving amazing effects. You will gain an understanding of how and when to lift wet pigment to reveal and suggest shapes and light. And you will learn how to enhance your focal point and to plan for a more successful composition.

In the first two days, Fabio will explain and demonstrate his original techniques for painting and lifting some of our favourite, and most challenging, florals- roses, tulips, daisies, violets, sunflowers, and peonies. On the third day, Fabio will critique students' work, and share his method for painting fields of poppies, and lavender as flowers in the landscape. Learn negative painting strategies and the successful sequencing of opaque and transparent glazes to create a luxurious patina and gentle glow to your work. You will explore brushwork techniques for creating textures and subtle transitions of delicate tints and muted hues and how to layer lost and found edges to suggest windswept meadows and distant trees.
