To whom it may concern,

P. Agnes, Inc. employed the use of Concure Systems Admixture on the Lankenau Hospital Expansion Project for all of the slab on grade applications in the new Heart Pavillion.

The majority of the flooring that was installed on those surfaces was Nora Rubber sheet flooring. The Concure Systems Admixture performed as promised by Concure, and in some cases, exceeded expectations. Bond tests were successful beyond our expectations and to date, nearly two (2) years after the flooring was installed, there have been no problems with these applications and the slab moisture was successfully mitigated. Since then, P. Agnes has incorporated Concure Admixture in the MD Anderson Cooper Cancer Center in Camden, NJ with great success. I would recommend the use of Concure to anyone considering it as an option for moisture mitigation in concrete slabs.
