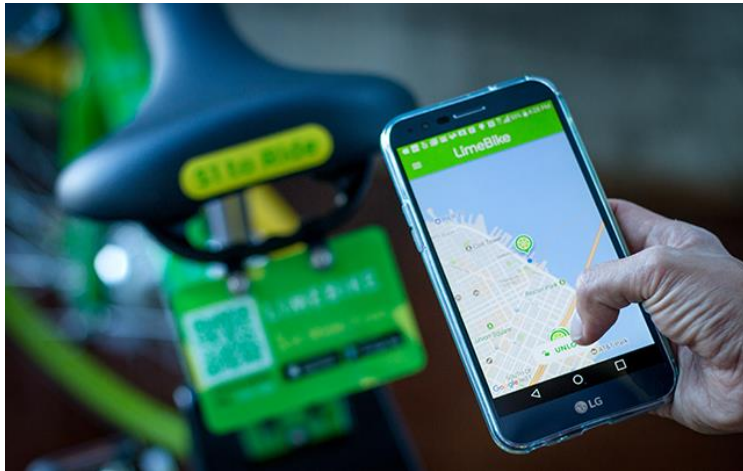

LIMEBIKE BIKESHARE LAUNCHES IN ITHACA

Bike Walk Tompkins, the City of Ithaca, & LimeBike partner in Ithaca, NY

Launched on April 29, 2018

The City of Ithaca, Bike Walk Tompkins (BWT), and LimeBike have partnered to launch a local dockless bikeshare program. Through this program, 200 LimeBikes are available for use. The bikes are largely located in downtown Ithaca and can be neatly parked anywhere at the end of a trip, as opposed to at designated stations. Bikes may be borrowed by downloading the LimeBike app and scanning the QR code on the desired bike. Rides cost \$1 per half hour for regular users. Discounted rates are available for users with a .edu email address and those receiving government assistance. BWT and the City are working closely to further develop the bikeshare and hope this program will encourage residents to bike as a convenient, green alternative to driving.

DOCKLESS BIKESHARE COMES TO CAMDEN

Ofo, Cooper's Ferry, Rutgers, & the City of Camden partner in Camden, NJ

Launched on May 1, 2018

The City of Camden, Ofo, Cooper's Ferry Partnership (CFP), the Voorhees Transportation Center at Rutgers University, and Get Healthy Camden have partnered to launch New Jersey's first dockless bikeshare program, Camden Bike Share, with support from the William Penn Foundation. Through this program, dockless Ofo bikes are available for rent throughout the city. Bikes can be booked via the Ofo app, ridden anywhere within city limits, and locked anywhere at the trip's end. The standard cost to ride is \$1 per hour, though CFP is also offering subsidized rates for low-income users. This pilot serves as a bikeshare feasibility and demonstration program for the City of Camden and aims to offer locals an easy, affordable way to get around Camden.
