- 1. TROT TOWARD CENTER OF ARENA.
- 2. EXTEND THE TROT TURNING RIGHT AT CENTER OF ARENA AND CONTINUE TO EXTEND THE TROT STRAIGHT THEN TURN RIGHT AGAIN.
- 3. AFTER TURNING THE CORNER, BREAK DOWN TO THE WALK AND DEMONSTRATE THE WALK.
- 4. LOPE ON THE RIGHT LEAD
- 5. EXTEND THE LOPE TO THE CENTER OF THE ARENA
- 6. EXECUTE A LEAD CHANGE AT THE CENTER OF ARENA (SIMPLE OR FLYING)
- 7. LOPE ON THE LEFT LEAD IN A CIRCLE AND STOP.
- 8. DEMONSTRATE A SIDE PASS TO THE RIGHT.
- 9. WALK FORWARD, THEN EXTEND THE TROT IN A STRAIGHT LINE AND TURN LEFT.
- 10. AFTER TURNING THE CORNER, COLLECT THE TROT
- 11. STOP AND BACK 10-15 FEET



- 1. BE IN CHUTE, BACK AROUND CORNER UP TO GATE.
- 2. GATE: LEFT HAND OPEN GATE, RIDE THRU AND CLOSE GATE.
- 3. JOG OVER POLES.
- 4. LOPE OVER POLES (LL).
- 5. BREAK TO THE JOG, JOG THRU SERPENTINE, JOG OVER CONES.
- 6. JOG OVER POLES.

- 7. LOPE OVER POLES (RL).
- 8. LOPE OVER POLES (RL).
- 9. BREAK TO THE JOG, JOG OVER POLES, STOP BEFORE BOX.
- 10. WALK INTO BOX, EXECUTE A 360 TURN EITHER WAY, WALK OUT BOX, WALK OVER POLES.
