FLAT RATE OPTION: \$335.00 per horse – multiple riders/multiple classes.

INCLUDES: all classes & office charge. Does NOT include: cattle charges, stall, shavings, trail warm up fees, AQHA processing fees, Special event classes, RV or office charge.

VRH exhibitors – if you show VRH <u>AND</u> any regular class, you will be charged an additional AQHA processing fee. MAX - \$30 additional not included in the flat rate. (AQHA rules – not HCHC)

If you enter Reining, you are not able to enter VRH Reining. Likewise with Trail and VRH Trail. AQHA rules.

AQHA Classes: \$16.00 per judge Cattle Fees: \$40.00 per run

Walk/trot Classes: \$10/judge/class - These are AQHA approved classes. Papers & cards required.

AQHA Fee: \$6.00 per horse/judge

(IF also showing VRH you will be charged an additional AQHA processing fee PER show - AQHA rules, not HCHC.)

Office Charge: \$10.00 per horse

Stalls: \$125.00 - flat rate circuit. Arrival on Tuesday. (Monday permitted with special permission.) \$50.00 - DAILY stall LIMITED numbers

\$250/\$500 added classes - Must show to all five judges (Wednesday does not count), Paid on circuit points - 40%/30%/20%/10%

Jump Out Fee: \$25.00 per day for those without stalls – limited space Shavings: \$8.00 per bag (NO outside shavings permitted)

Camping: \$30.00 per night

Trail Warm Up: \$10.00/show - 3 total shows

Circuit Awards in all AQHA Classes Must show to all applicable judges

Special Event Classes (Wednesday) do NOT count towards circuit or high points.
