



## **TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

Tickets sold for Inland Sea of Sound (“Event”) are provided on the express condition that the holder (“Ticketholder”) is bound by the rules & regulations issued by Bathurst Regional Council (“the Promoter”). Ticketholders agree to be bound by the Terms and Conditions contained herein and on the Event website.

1. Inland Sea of Sound is an all ages event.
2. Ticketholders aged 15 and under must be accompanied by a parent and/or adult guardian at all times, who must also hold a valid ticket to the Event. Please check the entertainment lineup to determine whether the Event is a suitable event for your child/ren to attend.
3. Your ticket will be exchanged for a wristband that you **MUST** keep on for the duration of the Event. Lost, damaged or stolen wristbands will not be replaced. 18+ wristbands will only be provided upon photo I.D. being presented. You must have an 18+ wristband if you wish to purchase alcohol.
4. The Venue, including the entertainment areas and car parks are licensed. Anyone found supplying or buying alcohol for a minor will be evicted from the Event & may face criminal charges. Any minor found consuming or in possession of alcohol will face similar action.
5. The Event is a fully licensed and catered event. No BYO food or drink is permitted apart from bottled water (plastic only) or particular foods required for dietary requirements. A water refill station will be available on site.
6. Admission is by valid ticket or complementary pass. The Promoter reserves the right to refuse entry.
7. Each ticket booking attracts a payment processing fee and an administration fee both of which are inclusive of GST.

8. No refunds on tickets except as required by law &/or specified by the Live Performance Australia Ticketing Code of Practice. Incorrect purchases DO NOT qualify for a refund or exchange.
9. No refunds will be issued on unused tickets or vouchers.
10. If you are removed from Venue and/or denied entry to the Venue or the Event, you will not be entitled to any ticket refund and/or compensation.
11. Event management reserves the right to refuse entry to the venue and vary advertised entertainment times.
12. By attending, all patrons must be willing to have their bag/s searched upon entry. Any food, drink, glass, video cameras (including Go Pros), illegal weapons or substances found will be confiscated.
13. Possession, sale or use of illegal drugs or illicit substances is strictly prohibited at the Venue and the Event. Any persons found with illegal drugs or illicit substances in their possession will be removed from the Venue and subject to Police action.
14. It is a condition of purchase that the Ticketholder consents to the Organiser collecting and retaining their personal information. The Organiser will hold your information as required by the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth) and for contacting you in relation to ticketing matters and Event information. The Organiser will not trade or sell your personal information.
15. Smoking is only permitted in the designated area/s. In the event of a heightened fire threat, smoking will not be permitted anywhere inside the venue.
16. Dogs and pets are not permitted with the exception of service or assistance animals, such as Guide Dogs.
17. Unruly or obnoxious behaviour will not be tolerated within the event site. Activities such as moshing, crowd surfing, climbing and stage diving are strictly prohibited. Patrons engaging in these or other dangerous activities will be removed from the Venue, and patrons accept all risk and liability for any injuries or damages caused by these activities. Entry to the Venue is at the Ticketholder's own risk.
18. Professional sound recording equipment must not be used unless pre-authorised by the Event Organisers.
19. The event will proceed at the venue in all weather conditions unless it poses a safety risk to Ticketholders, performers, staff and volunteers. If

the event is cancelled by Organisers for any reason prior to the gates opening, only the face value of the ticket will be refunded (excluding booking & handling fees). No refunds will be offered upon cancellation after the gates have opened.

20. Except where liability cannot be excluded by law, the Organiser (and its employees, contractors and agents) shall not be liable for any loss, cost, expense, injury, claim or damages suffered or sustained by any Ticketholders and patrons at the Venue or the Event. Where permitted under the Australian Consumer Law (ACL), the Organiser limits its liability in respect of breach of any statutory guarantee under the ACL in the manner set out in sections 64A(1)(a) and 64A(2)(a) of the ACL.
21. To the full extent permitted by law, Ticketholders waive all legal rights of action against and fully release the Organiser, its agents, employees and volunteers for all claims for compensation for loss, damage, injury or death howsoever arising out of or in relation to the Ticketholder's entry to and presence at the Venue and their attendance at the Event.
22. In the event of injury or illness the Organiser may, at the cost of the Ticketholder, arrange medical treatment and/or emergency evacuation as deemed essential for the safety of the Ticketholder.
23. Any provision of these Terms and Conditions which are or becomes unenforceable shall not invalidate the other provisions of these Terms and Conditions.
