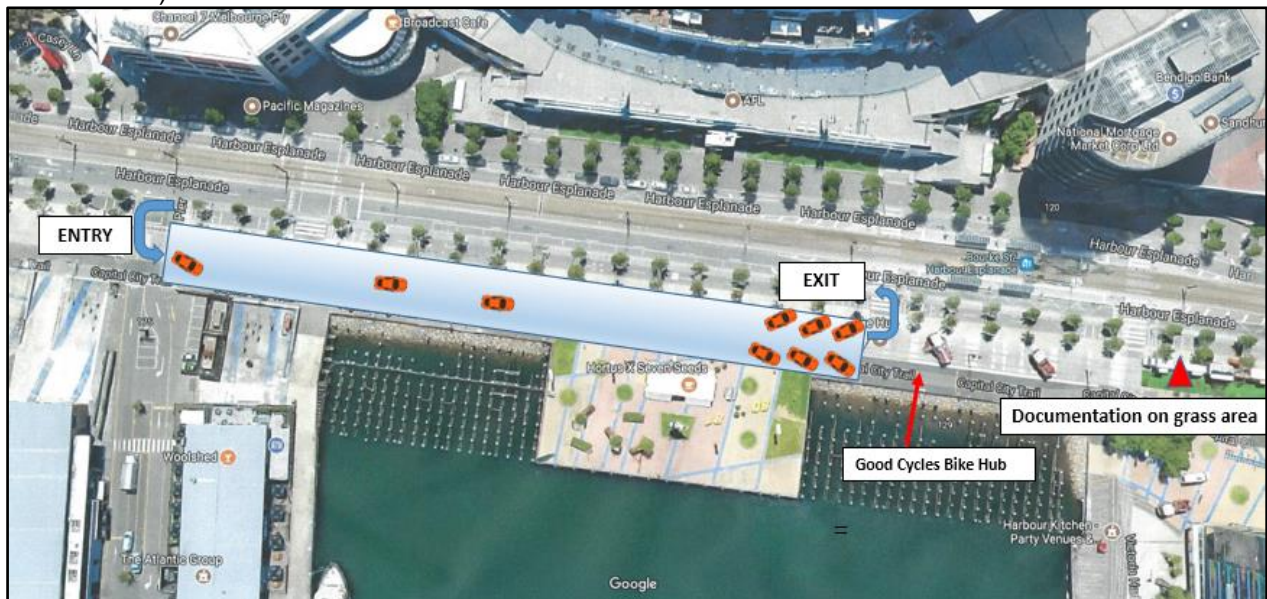
1. REPORTING FOR DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINY - WEDNESDAY 29 NOVEMBER

Competitors are required to report to Documentation and Scrutiny on Wednesday 29 November between **0900 and 1200 - the earlier the better.**

Day Routine

- arrive and park;
- attend Documentation;
- attend Scrutiny;
- fit RallySafe equipment;
- leave car on display to public;
- 1500 collect car and drive to the overnight car park (see handout for directions);
- 1545 attend Crew Briefing followed by Time Trial/Regularity Test Briefing for those interested.

On arrival please park as directed by the officials and then report to Documentation on the grass area (see sketch below).

At documentation crew members are required to:

- present completed entry form issued previously or fill one in;
- present civil driving licences for checking that they are current;
- **present vehicle registration papers**

Participants will be issued with:

- crew members personal identification - lanyard;
- vehicle decals;
- merchandise;
- road books, average speed chart, any previously issued bulletins (**NOTE: there are 85 pages in the Days 1 & 2 road book and 87 in Days 3 & 4 book on receipt; crews should check the page numbers and report any discrepancies to the Competitor Relations Officer, Jim Reddix (0478 819 950).**);
- a RallySafe unit;
- a route chart from the Boulevard to the overnight car park after documentation and scrutiny is completed;

- Book by Bob Watson: 'Fangio to Phillip Island'.

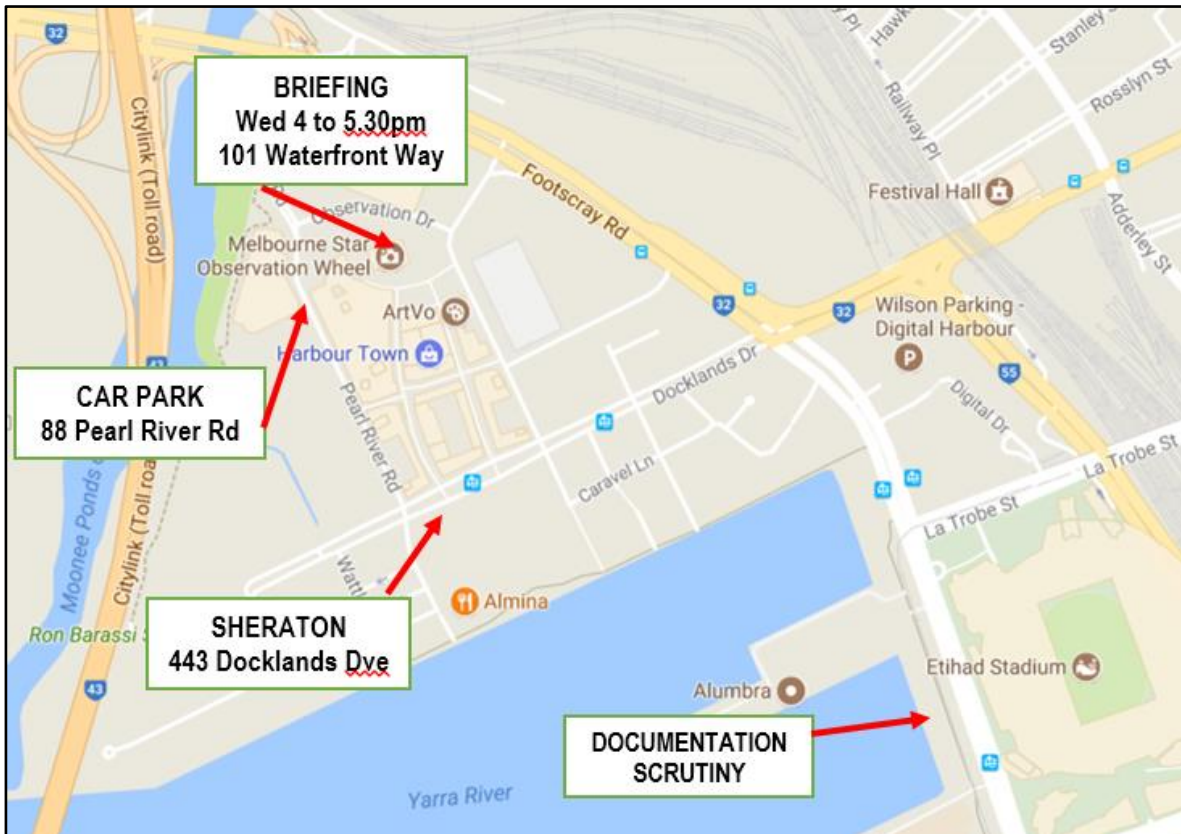
Scrutineers will examine the vehicle in accordance with the Scrutiny Check Sheet issued in the Guide to the Event.

RallySafe: Chiefs - Wayne Maxwell / Mike Widdowson

RallySafe equipment will be fitted to the vehicle.

2. WEDNESDAY - PARKING AFTER DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINY

Cars are to be securely parked in the overnight car park at Docklands - see handout at Documentation for a route chart to the car park at 88 Pearl River Road.



3. WEDNESDAY - CREW BRIEFING

NOTE that the briefing will be at this location and NOT the Sheraton Hotel as previously noted.

1. Participants Briefing

A briefing for participants will be conducted:

- Wednesday 29 November, 1600 to 1645, arrival from 1545;
- at the Melbourne Star Observation Wheel, 101 Waterfront Way, Docklands (see above sketch).

At least one member of each crew must attend this briefing.

2. Time Trial and Regularity Test Briefing

A Time Trial and Regularity Test briefing and explanation will be conducted immediately after the Participants Briefing for those interested to attend. Time will be 1700 to 1730.

4. THURSDAY - START FROM OVERNIGHT CAR PARK IN DOCKLANDS

1. If a vehicle is not parked in the overnight car park please report by 1000.
2. The first vehicle is to leave at 1030 and other vehicles are to leave at about 30 second intervals.
3. Details of how to travel to the Eastern Beach Reserve in Geelong is listed in the road book
4. Fuel service stations along the way are listed in the road book.
5. Please follow the instructions of the officials.
