Directions

From the north (Portland)

From **I-5 S**, take exit **282A** toward **Canby/Hubbard**.
Merge onto **Hubbard Cutoff Rd NE**.
Turn **left** at **Arndt Rd NE**. Continue on **S Knights Bridge Rd**.
Conference center entrance is on the **left** (before bridge).

From the south (Salem)

From **I-5 N**, take **exit 278** toward **Aurora National Historic District/Donald**.
Turn **right** at **Ehlen Rd NE**.
Turn **left** at **Hubbard Cutoff Rd NE**.
Turn **right** at **Arndt Rd NE**. Continue on **S Knights Bridge Rd**.
Conference center entrance is on the **left** (before bridge).

From I-205 (Oregon City)

From **I-205 S/Veterans Memorial Hwy**, take **exit 9** for **OR-99E** toward **Oregon City/Gladstone**. Turn **left** at **McLoughlin Blvd/OR-99E**.
Continue to follow OR-99E. Turn **right** at **S Grant St**.
Turn **left** at **N Knights Bridge Rd**.
Conference center entrance is on the **right**, just over the Molalla River Bridge.

Accommodation Options

Riverfront Lodge – This is where our main meeting space will be. Most sleeping rooms in the Lodge are designed for 1-4 guests, with a queen bed, bunk bed, linens and towels, and private bath. There are two handicapped-accessible rooms with a queen bed only, and a few larger rooms which accommodate 3-6 guests with a queen and two sets of bunk beds.

Cottages – Three cottages hold 2-4 guests each, with a queen bed, bunk bed, small table and two chairs, linens and towels, and full bath.

Woodland Cabins – Nine small cabins, each with a queen bed, bunk bed, small table and two chairs, hold up to 4 guests each. Guests bring their own towels and bed linens or sleeping bags. Restroom and shower facilities are near the cabin area. One or two of the cabins will be reserved for young adults depending upon number registered.

Children and Youth

Childcare and children's programs will be available throughout the conference. Youth are encouraged to participate fully in all of the conference activities, and a youth coordinator will assist youth in planning their own activities.

All children and youth under 18 years of age must be supervised by adults at all times. This is especially critical when using recreational areas.

Recreation

Recreation opportunities include tennis, Gaga Ball, pickle-ball, basketball, hiking, horseshoes, volleyball, music and board games.

Music

Meals & Snacks
