

How to Make an American Girl Doll Chair




Materials

- 1 large box (cereal)
- 2 medium boxes same size (lunch kit, granola, or cake box)
- 2 small boxes same size (mac-n-cheese)
- 2 drink bottles
- shredded paper (get from an office or school)
- 1 yard of fabric
- low temp hot glue gun
- 10-20 sticks of glue
- scissors
- batting (the stuffing in a blanket)




Directions


- 1. Densly pack **all five boxes** with **shredded paper** and tape or glue shut.
- 2. Glue each **bottle** to a **small box**. **TIP:** It helps to set it on a table like pictured while the glue sets up.




3. Cover all pieces in a layer of batting using the hot glue gun.




- 3. **LARGE and MEDIUM BOXES** Cut a rectangle of fabric for the 3 boxes like you are going to wrap each like a gift.
- 4. Wrap the boxes just like you would a gift. Use the glue to "tape" everything closed.



- 5. **ARMS OF CHAIR** Cut 2 solid "P" shapes. Cut a rectangle of fabric to go around the outside of the arm.
- 6. Glue the "P" shapes on the front of the arm.




7. Before you wrap the arm, fold the raw (uncut) edge over. Glue around the outside of the arm.




- 8. Wrap the back of the arm like a gift and glue in place. There is really no. wrong way to do it!
- 9. Stack and glue the two medium boxes together to make the SEAT.



10. Glue the **ARMS** to the **SEAT.** Use lots of glue and squeeze together tight until the glue sets up.



5. Glue on the **BACK** of the chair (the large box)



Helpful TIP: As you glue all the pieces together, it might be helpful to use **a belt** or **a rope** to squeeze all the pieces together so the glue can set up.
