Characters and Requirements

ANNIE

- The spunky and optimistic 11 year old orphan.
- Playing age 8-12
- Audition songs - “Maybe” and “Tomorrow”
- Lib - Documents entitled ORPHANS and ANNIE

****All below characters will need to sing “Hard Knock Life” and “Never Fully Dressed”. Their Audition Script is the “Orphans Script”****

Molly

- The youngest orphan who is Annie’s best friend
- Playing age 6-8

Pepper

- The bossiest orphan who is not good friends with Annie
- Playing age 11-13

Duffy

- The oldest orphan who is friends with everyone
- Playing age 14-16

July

- The quietest orphan who is the mother to everyone
- Playing Age 11-13

Tessie

- The cry baby famous for the line “oh my goodness”
- Playing age 8-10

Kate

- The shyest orphan who very rarely speaks
- Playing age 7-9
