



Educational Visits - What can we do?

Following the government's DfE guidance issued 26th March 2021 the below is a visual representation for how school trips may return after 12th April 2021. Any educational day visits must be conducted in line with relevant coronavirus (COVID-19) secure guidelines and regulations in place at that time. This includes system of controls, such as keeping children within their consistent groups and the COVID-secure measures in place at the destination.



Local Learning Area

In addition to using your own school grounds, you are able to use outdoor areas adjacent to and near the school for educational activities. We refer to these as your 'Local Learning Area'.



Farm & Zoo Visits

Visit zoos, parks, farms, field studies centres, environmental centres and other outdoor spaces which are not local to the school.



Museum Visits

Visit indoor spaces such as museums, education centres, castles etc.



Adventure Centre Visits

Make bookings and use Outdoor Education or Adventure centres for day trips.

What about residential visits?

You may also plan and prepare for residential activities to resume from no earlier than the 17th May 2021. This could include camping on the school field, sleeping in the school hall, staying at a residential centre or using a campsite. See our FAQs for how these should be booked.
